**2016 FAI 1E EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR FREE FLIGHT
MODEL AIRCRAFT FOR SENIORS AND JUNIORS
20-24 JULY 2016, TURDA, ROMANIA**

BULLETIN 1

ORGANIZER: The Romanian Modelling Federation, in co-operation with Romanian Aero Club, City Hall Turda and military authorities.

DATE: 20-24 July 2016

VENUE: The town of Turda, situated North-West of Romania, in Transilvania, 35 km far from Cluj Napoca, and 435 km far from Bucharest.

The flying site is on "Bogata" hills close to city of Turda (15 km), where 2003, 2007 World Championships F1E and European Championships 1996, 2000, 2006, 2010 and 2012 took place.

Starting with 1994, we organize two World Cup contest every year in "Bogata" hill.

The height difference between lowest and highest point of that area is 100-200 m and the site is grass covered.

There are no agricultural fields, houses, trees or any other obstacles within the area.

The European Championship and the two World Cup contests will take place on the flying site South of Bogata Hill, where 2011 World Cup and 2003 World Championship took place. The two opposed slopes, are oriented South (to Alba Iulia) and North (to Turda). The wind direction for the two slopes in August is favourable for the contest. The access road is repaired, allowing access by car to the contest site.

Turda can be reached from any direction driving on E81.

Cluj can be reached by plane from any direction by car, train, and airplane.

Campia Turzii (15 km far from Turda) can be reached from any direction by train.

RULES: The F.A.I. Sporting Code, General Section, Sporting Code Section 4a, 4b, 4c.

AWARDS: The Organizer will offer FAI medals and diplomas, cups to the first three in individual and team classification (including the Team Manager).

The FAI Perpetual Trophies will be awarded:

Senior Champion: Europa Pokal 1984 AUT Trophy (current holder Maurizio Tomazzoni, ITA)

Junior Champion: Rhon Pokal of 2008 Trophy (current holder Florian Winker, GER)

PARTICIPANTS: Each National Aeroclub/National Federation may enter a team consisting of 3 seniors, 3 juniors, team manager, team manager's assistant, 2014 European senior Champion, 2014 European junior Champion (if still junior), one time keeper ,helpers, supporters, press representative. The 2014 Junior Champion can compete either in junior championship if still junior or in senior championship if now longer a junior.

AGE OF JUNIORS AND THEIR HELPERS: (Sporting Code, para.B.3.4): "A competitor is considered to be a junior up to and including the calendar year in which he attains the age of 18"

FAI LICENSE: Each competitor and TM must possess a valid FAI license for 2016 and registered in FAI database.

CONTEST DIRECTOR: Mihail Zanciu, Romania

TIME KEEPERS: Each National Team may participate with one timekeeper for whom the organizer will provide full board and lodging, local transportation, banquet, souvenirs, trip for all activity in the World Championships and World Cups.

The time keepers are requested to bring their own binoculars, tripod and stopwatches.

OFFICIAL LANGUAGE: English and Romanian.

ENTRY FEES: 250 EURO /senior competitor, TM, TM's Assistant,
200 EURO/junior competitor,
50 EURO/supporter, helper.
50 EURO-protest fee

All these entry fees cover only participation in the European Championships and souvenirs.

ANTI DOPING

Quote from the FAI Anti-Doping regulations:

If you regularly take medication prescribed by your doctor and this medication is on the WADA Prohibited List, you need to get a form called a TUE (therapeutic use exemption) filled out by your doctor. International level athletes must send the form to the FAI Secretariat, National level athletes send it to their National Air Sport Control.

BOARD AND LODGING: The Organizer will provide board and lodging in Turda and Stejeris in 3 hotels (Stejeris, Sungarden, AA two star) with double room, single room, bath room, Tv, **40-50 EURO/pers/day**, including breakfast and dinner in restaurants hotels and hot lunch, mineral water on contest site.

In Turda there are 4 family pensions of two star category and two hotels of four and five star category.

For 6/ 7 days: 264-308 EURO/pers.

LUNCH AT CONTEST SITE: 8 EUR/pers/day

BANQUET: 35 EURO/senior; 30 EURO/junior.

THE TIME SCHEDULE:

- **Monday, July the 18th** - arrival, registration, accommodation;
- **Tuesday, July the 19th** - **“Memorial Popa Cringu”, World Cup**(optional)
- **Wednesday July the 20th** - registration, model checking, training, opening ceremony, technical meeting;
- **Thursday, July the 21st** - **European Championships for juniors;**
- **Friday, July the 22nd** - **European Championships for seniors;**
- **Saturday, July the 23rd** - meteo reserve day/trip, prize awarding and closing ceremony and Banquet;
- **Sunday, July the 24th** - **World Cup Turda-optional**, departure of participants
- **Sunday, July the 25th** - reserve day for Turda Cup and departure of the participants.

WEATHER FORECAST at the end of August is usually good for F1E Class.

- average daily temperature: 23⁰C;
- moderate windspeed of 2-6 m/s, and no more than a shower weekly;

Insurance

EU Citizens must bring European Health Insurance card.

Citizens from outside EU should provide their own health insurance to cover illness and travel insurance.

The Organizers are not responsible for any kind of PERSONAL injury, loss, theft or damage to people or property OUTSIDE OF THE COMPETITION.

The Organizers will cover third party damage during the contest.

ENTRY VISA: For those countries where the Romanian Entry Visa is asked for, it can be obtained from The Romanian Embassies/Consulates. Citizens belonging to the countries members of EU do not need an Entry Visa.

Preliminary Entry Form should be sent to the Organizers no later than the 31st of January 2016

At the same time, the Entry Fees for Team Manager, Team Manager's Assistant, Senior competitors, Junior Competitors, Helpers, Supporters, should be sent to the following bank account no later than the 15th of March 2016

Payments sent after the 15th of March will be subject of a fine:

15th of March- 15th of April :**10% fine**

15th of April – 15th of May: **20% fine**

15th of May-30th of June: **30% fine**
