

Hangars

Hangars to the competitor's disposal will be available from August 20th through August 27th.

Each team will have a maintenance area with tables, chairs and 220V power supply.

Hangars will be protected and guarded round the clock.

The overall area of the two neighboring hangars is 2440 m² (26263 ft²)

Transportation from the hangar to flightline: within walking distance (100m):each competitor will transport his own model and equipment.

Participation

A National team may consist of (per class C and/or H):

- -1 Team Manager
- -Maximum 3 senior competitors
- -1 Junior competitor
- -Helpers and supporters

The 2014 World Champion is invited to take part.

If he is not member of the national team, his score will not be considered in the team results.

Licensing

Each competitor, team manager and team manager assistant must possess a valid FAI License, valid 2016, issued by their NAC and present in the FAI database.

Classification and awards

There will be an individual classification and a team classification.

Winners will be awarded with medals, diplomas and cups.

Protest : All protests must be presented in writing to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 50 EUR.

The deposit is returned if the protest is upheld only.

All fees must be received by April 1STth.

Entries received from April 1st to May 15th will be subject of 10% fine.

Entries received from May 15th to July 1st will be subject of 20% fine.

Entries received after July 1st will be subject of 30 % fine.

Payment is to be made by banking transfer.

The banking commission is in charge of sender, so that the whole amount of money from the entry form should be received in the Organizer's bank account.

Payment by check is not accepted.

Model processing

Each competitor must present a valid FAI Specification Certificate for his model, according to FAI Sporting Code Volume ABR/Section 4 Aeromodelling.

Model aircraft not properly processed by NAC, must be processed by the organizer at a cost of 8 EUR for each model.

Each competitor must present a Competitors Declaration Form according to FAI Sporting Code Volume 4/Section 4 Aeromodelling (annex 6.E. page 72 of the scale rules).

National flag and anthem

The Team Manager is requested to bring one national flag of $1 \times 1,5$ m and a CD with national anthem.

The flag and anthem will be collected during the team's registration and returned after the closing ceremony.

Documents for registration:

- Competitor's FAI License valid for 2016 and registered in the FAI database
- A copy of team's banking payment receipt
- One national flag 1 x 1,5 m
- One CD with national anthem
- Valid FAI certificates for the models
- Valid ID card

Fuel for models

The local dealer HELI.ro will supply, on request, the following types of **RAPICON** fuel (synthetic oil):

The company is able to ensure the transport of the model boxes from the airport to the contest site, and back.

The estimated cost for one way (Bucharest-Contest site) is 100 EUR/ transport, regardless the number of boxes. For this, the teams should contact Delta Travel and send the dimensions of each box, in cm.

All the teams must do all the paper work with the custom on the airport, as Delta Travel has no personnel prepared for this kind of work.

For the teams sending the boxes directly to contest site by DHL or any other fast courier:

the boxes will be received by organizers starting with the 18th of August and stored until the teams will arrive.
