- **COVID-19 information**

Team Managers will present to the Registration for verification, a list of participants and copies of the vaccination / testing documents.

According to the provisions of the Protocol sent for approval to the FAI-CIAM Bureau, the organizer will take all measures to ensure that this championship will take place safely (for correct and complete information, find the document on the competition website).

However, to avoid any possibility of infection, as well as periodic testing, our recommendation is to get vaccinated. If all participants are vaccinated, we have no restrictions during the championships or free time.

Depending on the evolution of the situation of COVID-19 in the world, it is necessary that each person participating in the World Championships respects the special rules of hygiene.

Art.9¹ of the Decision of the National Committee for Emergency Situations no.43 of 01.07.2021 on the approval of the list of countries / territories of high epidemiological risk, the criteria on the basis of which they are established, as well as the rules for applying the quarantine measure on persons arriving of these in Romania, with subsequent amendments and completions (introduced by the Decision of the National Committee for Emergency Situations no. 51 of 26.07.2021 for the amendment and completion of the Decision of the National Committee for Emergency Situations no. 43 of 01.07.2021 on approving the list of countries / territories of high epidemiological risk, the criteria on the basis of which they are established, as well as the rules for applying the quarantine measure on persons arriving from them in Romania):

The entry into Romania for the holders of the EU Covid Certificate is based on it.

They will be exempted from quarantine even if they come from the area with a high risk of infection (red or yellow area).

In the case of persons who do not have this certificate, the provision shall be observed:

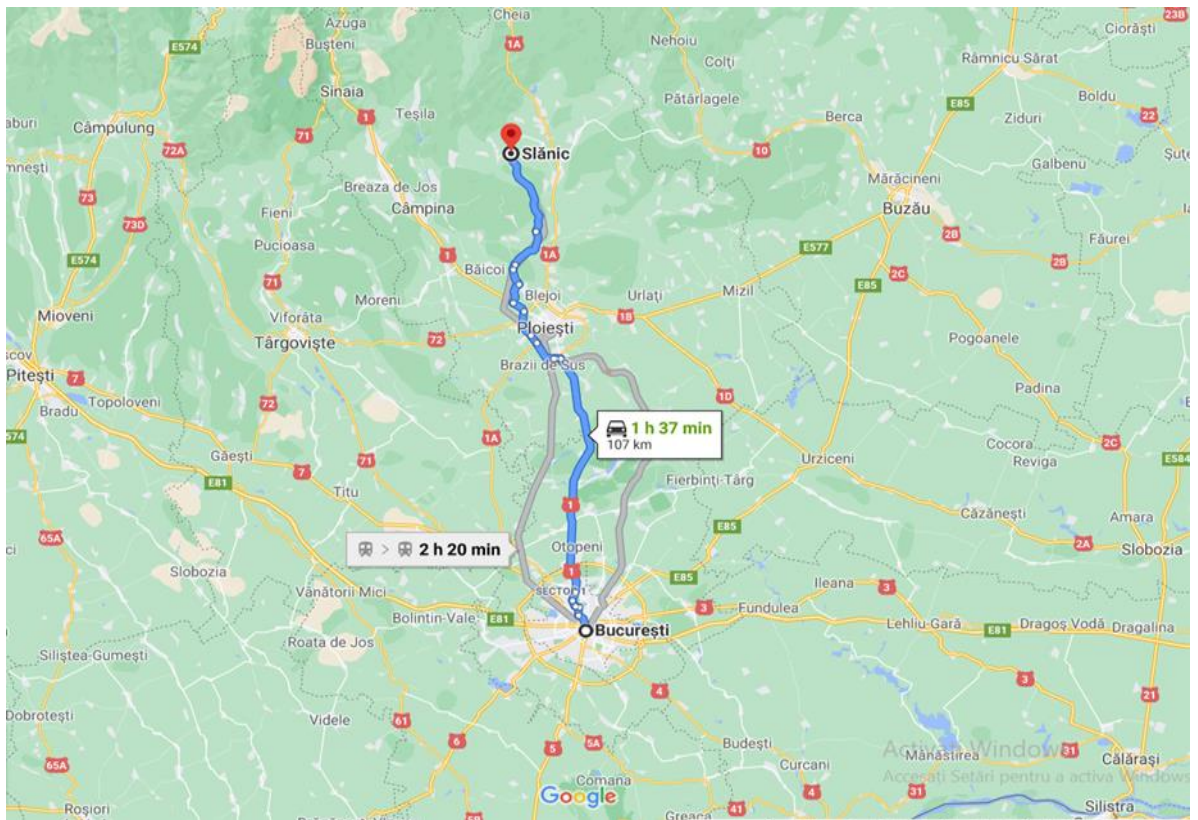
(1) The members of sports delegations arriving in Romania to participate in sports competitions organized on national territory, from countries in the red zone of epidemiological risk are exempted from the quarantine measure established according to the provisions of this decision, if they present the negative result of an RT-PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 infection performed no later than 72 hours before entering the country and participating only in activities within the mentioned competitions.

All delegations will present Bulletin 2 to the customs police to prove their participation in the championship.

- **ORGANISER AND LOCATION**

- Romanian Modeling Federation in cooperation with the City Council of Slanic and the Salrom Company.
- The field will be the same that was used for all of the F1D International Championships held in Salt Mine in Slanic. The field is very well known among F1D flyers and situated coming at 104 km away from Bucharest.
- The coordinates for contest site are: 45° 14' 0" N, 25° 56' 21" E.
- The underground Hall "UNIREA", 70 m below Hall "Mihai"; Height: 56 m (Cat.IV); Length: 100 m; Width: 33 m; Average temperature: 11 degrees C.
- Access to Hall "Unirea" by minivans, provided by the salt mine company.



- **RULES**

The championship will run according to:

- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 – Aeromodelling CIAM General Rules 2021 Edition FAI
- Sporting Code Section 4 – Aeromodelling Volume F1 Free Flight Model Aircraft 2021
- FAI Sporting Code General Section and FAI Code of Ethics 2021 Edition;
- Increase of junior age authorised by CIAM Bureau.

Anti-Doping Statement:

If a competitor has to take, by a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Quotation from the FAI anti-doping regulations: “If you regularly take medication prescribed by your doctor and this medication is on the WADA prohibited list, you need to get a form called a TUE (therapeutic use exemption) filled out by your doctor. International level athletes must send the form to the FAI Secretariat, national level athletes send it to their National Air Sport Control”.

FAI Sporting License: each competitor and team manager must possess a FAI Sporting License valid for the year of the championship. This license must be registered in the FAI licenses database.

Note: The holder of a FAI Sporting License may be required to produce an official document bearing his photograph and signature as proof of identity.

- **COMPOSITION OF A NATIONAL TEAM**

Each National Aero-club/National Federation, member of the FAI-CIAM may enter a team consisting of:

- team manager, team manager assistant;
- senior competitors: maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female;
- Junior competitors (age limit 19 years under special extension authorised by CIAM Bureau): maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female.
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning senior World Champion
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning junior World Champion (referring to the CIAM General Rule 2021; sections C.5.1 and C.5.3. d)
- official helpers, supporters

- **CLASSIFICATION AND AWARDS**

Individual classification

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors seniors and juniors placed first, second and third.

The championships winner earns the title of World Champion irrespective of the number of nations.

The reigning World Champion 2018 (subject to the approval of his NAC) to participate in the championship(s) in that class regardless of whether or not he qualifies for the national team. If he is not a member of the national team, his score or place will not be considered in the team results.

- **BOARD AND LODGING**

- HOTEL ROBERTO and HOTEL TEJU

The organizer can provide accommodation and accommodation, at Hotel ROBERTO and HOTEL TEJU, 3 * (double rooms with bathroom, TV, wi-fi) - 45 EURO / pers / day, including breakfast and dinner.**

Located in the center of Slanic, 550 meters from the salt mine, Hotel Roberto and HOTEL TEJU offers rooms with free Wi-Fi and room service. The hotel also has a restaurant where you can serve all your daily meals.

All rooms are spacious and come with a private bathroom and satellite TV. At the Hotel ROBERTO will also organize the award ceremony and banquet.

For your health and safety of all participants in the competition, please do not choose other accommodation spaces that are not monitored by the organizer. Otherwise you will be directly responsible for the consequences of the choice you make.

The Organizer will provide lunch on the contest site for 10 Euro or only lunch and dinner 30 Euro per day for each person.

- **INSURANCE**

The organizer will provide a limited third-party liability insurance covering all competitors for model accidents involving injury to others and damage to property.

It is recommended that individual health and travel insurance is purchased before travelling. For EU citizens, health care is covered under Social Health Care on presentation of an EU 11 form available in the country of residence.

Citizens from outside of EU should provide their own health insurance to cover illness and travel insurance.

The Organizers are not responsible for any kind of PERSONAL injury, loss, theft or damage to people or property OUTSIDE OF THE COMPETITION.

The Organizers will cover third party damage during the contest.

- **Visa requirements**

For those countries where the Romanian Entry Visa is asked for, it can be obtained from The Romanian Embassies/Consulates. For more information please consult the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. (www.mae.ro/en/node/2040)

Citizens belonging to the countries members of EU do not need an Entry Visa.

- **Registration of the national teams**

On registration, the Team Manager must present the FAI licenses, an updated entry form (if any changes), a national flag (1m x 1,5m), national anthem on memory stick and the payment order only if paid late.

- **Transportation**

The organizer will provide free transportation to FAI jury members and teams at their request, for the amount of 20 euros / person from the international airport "Henri Coanda" to Slanic. Also, the organizer provided free transport to Mina Unirea for the members of the FAI jury and for teams at their request, for the amount of 5 euro / person / day. Payments will be made during registration.
