



• ORGANISER AND LOCATION

- Romanian Modeling Federation in cooperation with the City Council of Slanic and the Salrom Company.
- The field will be the same that was used for all of the F1D International Championships held in Salt Mine in Slanic. The field is very well known among F1D flyers and situated coming at 104 km away from Bucharest.
- The coordinates for contest site are: 45° 14′ 0″ N, 25° 56′ 21″ E.
- The underground Hall "UNIREA", 70 m below Hall "Mihai"; Height: 56 m (Cat.IV); Length: 100 m; Width: 33 m; Average temperature: 11 degrees C.
- Access to Hall "Unirea" by minivans, provided by the salt mine company.



• RULES

The championship will run according to:

- FAI Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling CIAM General Rules 2024 Edition FAI
- Sporting Code Section 4 Aeromodelling Volume F1 Free Flight Model Aircraft 2024
- FAI Sporting Code General Section and FAI Code of Ethics 2024 Edition;
- FAI Antidoping Rules;
- FAI Disciplinary Code.

Anti-Doping Statement:

If a competitor has to take, by a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Quotation from the FAI anti-doping regulations: "If you regularly take medication prescribed by your doctor and this medication is on the WADA prohibited list, you need to get a form called a TUE (therapeutic use exemption) filled out by your doctor. International level athletes must send the form to the FAI Secretariat, national level athletes send it to their National Air Sport Control".

FAI Sporting License: each competitor and team manager must possess a FAI Sporting License valid for the year of the championship. This license must be registered in the FAI licenses database.

Note: The holder of a FAI Sporting License may be required to produce an official document bearing his photograph and signature as proof of identity.

• COMPOSITION OF A NATIONAL TEAM

Each National Aero-club/National Federation, member of the FAI-CIAM may enter a team consisting of:

- team manager, team manager assistant;
- Senior competitors: maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female;
- Junior competitors (age limit 18 years in the year 2024): maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female.
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning senior World Champion
- according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning junior World Champion (referring to the CIAM General Rule 2024; sections C.5.1 and C.5.3. d)
- official helpers, supporters

CLASSIFICATION AND AWARDS

Individual classification

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors seniors and juniors placed first, second and third.

The championships winner earns the title of World Champion subject to the requirements of Sporting Code Volume CGR.

FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third placed females only if six (6) or more females are competing. If the number of females participants is less than this number (six), then only FAI diplomas will be awarded

The best female earns the title of Female World or Continental Champion if females from at least four different nations participate in that class and the total number of females are six (6) or more.

The reigning World Champion 2022 (subject to the approval of his NAC) to participate in the championship(s) in that class regardless of whether or not he qualifies for the national team. If he is not a member of the national team, his score or place will not be considered in the team results.

• PROTESTS:

All protests must be presented in writing to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 50 EUR. The deposit is to be returned if the protest is upheld only.

• ENTRY FEES

• DEADLINES:

Preliminary Entry Form should be sent to the Organizers no later than the January 15, 2024. Final Entry Form (to be sent with Bulletin 2) and the Entry Fees should be sent no later than the 15th of February 2024.

Payments sent after February 15, 2024, shall include a 10% surcharge.

Payments sent after March 1, 2022, shall include a 20% surcharge.

• BOARD AND LODGING

➤ HOTEL ROBERTO

The organizer can provide accommodation and accommodation, at Hotel ROBERTO 3 *** (double rooms with bathroom, TV, wi-fi - 70 EURO / pers / day, including breakfast and dinner. Single rooms with bathroom, TV, wi-fi - 80 EURO / pers / day, including breakfast and dinner.

Located in the center of Slanic, 550 meters from the salt mine, Hotel Roberto offer rooms with free Wi-Fi and room service. The hotel also has a restaurant where you can serve all your daily meals.

All rooms are spacious and come with a private bathroom and satellite TV. At the Hotel ROBERTO will also organize the award ceremony and banquet.

The Organizer will provide lunch on the contest site for 10 Euro or only lunch and dinner 30 Euro per day for each person.

Banquet

50 EURO/senior; 40 EURO/junior.

• INSURANCE

The organizer will provide a third-party liability insurance covering all competitors for model accidents involving injury to others and damage to property.

It is recommended that individual health and travel insurance is purchased before travelling. For EU citizens, health care is covered under Social Health Care on presentation of an EU 11 form available in the country of residence.

Citizens from outside of EU should provide their own health insurance to cover illness and travel insurance.

The Organizers are not responsible for any kind of PERSONAL injury, loss, theft or damage to people or property OUTSIDE OF THE COMPETITION.

The Organizers will cover third party damage during the contest.

• Visa requirements

For those countries where the Romanian Entry Visa is asked for, it can be obtained from The Romanian Embassies/Consulates. For more information please consult the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. (www.mae.ro/en/node/2040)

Citizens belonging to the countries members of EU do not need an Entry Visa.

• Registration of the national teams

On registration, the Team Manager must present the FAI licenses, an updated entry form (if any changes), two national flags (1m x 1,5m), national anthem on memory stick and the payment order only if paid late.

• Transportation

The organizer will provide free transportation to FAI jury members and teams at their request, for the amount of 30 euros / person from the international airport "Henri Coanda" to Slanic. Also, the organizer provided free transport to Mina Unirea for the members of the FAI jury and for teams at their request, for the amount of 10 euro / person / day. Payments will be made during registration.
