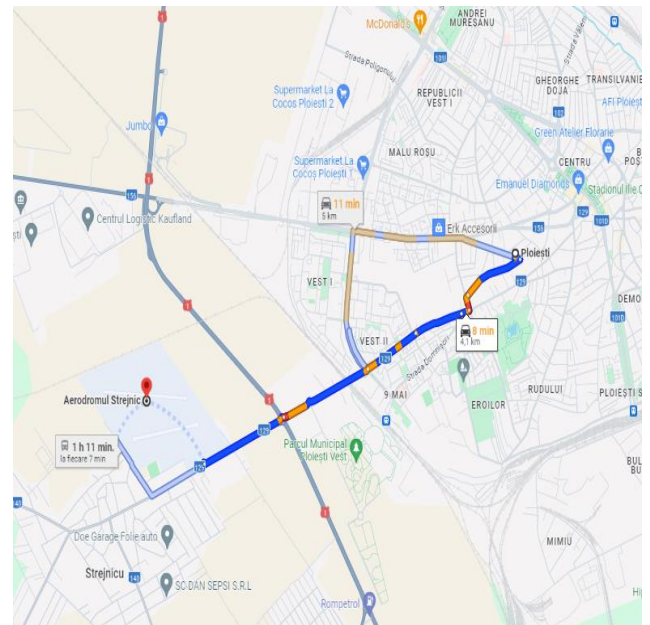
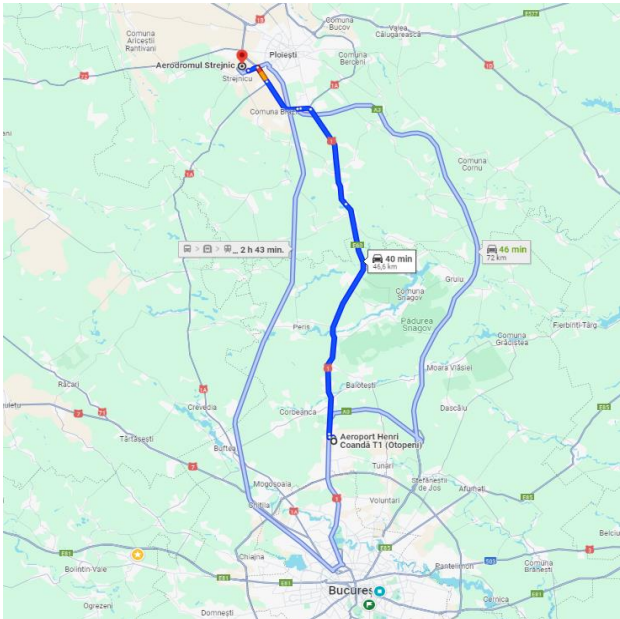

- **ORGANISER AND LOCATION**

The Romanian Modelling Federation, in co-operation with Romanian Aero Club and military authorities.

- The town of Strejnic, situated South-East of Romania, in Ploiesti, 82 km far from Bucharest
- The flying site is on “Strejnic” close to city of Ploiesti (6 km), where The World Championship in 2016 took place. The weather in August is favorable for the contest.
- The coordinates for the contest site are: 44° 55' 31" N, 25° 57' 42" E.



- **RULES**

The championship will be run according to: - FAI Sporting Code 2023 edition, CIAM General Rules and Volume F4. - FAI General Section and FAI Code of Ethics. Anti-Doping Statement: If a competitor has to take, by a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI. www.wada-ama.org
 Quotation from the FAI anti-doping regulations: “If you regularly take medication prescribed by your doctor and this medication is on the WADA prohibited list, you need to get a form called a TUE (therapeutic use exemption) filled out by your doctor. International level athletes must send the form to the FAI Secretariat, national level athletes send it to their National Air Sport Control”.

FAI Sporting Licence: each competitor and team manager must possess a FAI Sporting Licence valid for the year of the championship. This licence must be registered in the FAI licences database. Note: The holder of a FAI Sporting Licence may be required to produce an official document bearing his photograph and signature as proof of identity.

- **COMPOSITION OF A NATIONAL TEAM**

Each National Aero-club/National Federation, member of the FAI-CIAM may enter a team consisting of: - team manager, team manager assistant - senior competitors: maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female; - junior competitors (age limit 18 years in the year 2023): maximum 3 competitors or a maximum of 4 competitors if at least one competitor is female; - according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning senior World Champion - according to the FAI Sporting Code, the reigning junior World Champion (referring to the CIAM General Rule 2023; sections C.5.1 and C.5.3. d); - official helpers, supporters.

- **CLASSIFICATION AND AWARDS**

Individual classification

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to the competitors seniors and juniors placed first, second and third. All senior Females will compete for the overall senior individual classification. Additionally, there is a senior Female classification both with FAI medals and diplomas.

All Junior Females will compete for the overall junior individual classification. Additionally, there is a junior Female classification both with FAI medals and diplomas.

FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third overall juniors. If only one or two overall juniors, compete in the class, they shall be awarded an FAI medal and diploma.

FAI medals and diplomas will be awarded to the first, second and third placed females, junior or senior. If only one or two females, junior or senior, compete in the class, they shall be awarded an FAI medal and diploma.

In order to award the title of Junior World Champion, junior competitors from at least four nations must participate. In order to award the title of Senior Female World Champion, senior female competitors from at least four nations must participate.

In order to award the title of Junior Female World Champion, junior female competitors from at least four nations must participate.

The reigning World Champion 2022 (subject to the approval of his NAC) to participate in the championship in that class regardless of whether or not he qualifies for the national team. If he is not a member of the national team, his score or place will not be considered in the team results.

Team classification

FAI medals and FAI diplomas will be awarded to each member (including three competitors with the best results and the team manager) of the teams placed first, second and third.

Other awards

The Organizer will offer trophies to all the competitors in the team and the team manager.

- **The Flightline**

We will use the flightline both RC classes. Main runway is tarmac, F4B will be in the front of hangar nr. 2.

- **Model Crates (Transport and Shipment)**

A return address label for your model crate must be provided by each pilot at the conclusion of the Scale World Championship and affixed to the model crate by the pilot.

Shipments by any other means or car/camper/truck must be handled directly by the model owner or pilot.

- **Fuel, Gas, Batteries and Compressed Air**

Power plugs for air compressors and charging devices are delivered by the organizers for each team at their space in the model hangar.

PROTESTS:

All protests must be presented in writing to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 50 Euro. The deposit is to be returned if the protest is upheld only.

ENTRY FEES

€ 600 per Senior Competitor, Team Manager, Assistant Team Manager

€ 300 per Junior Competitor

€ 100 per Supporter, Helper, Caller, Mechanic

Sanction Fee for each Team Manager and Competitor - €10 - The payment of this part of the sanction fees must be transferred by the organizer to the CIAM.

A competitor who will be also a team manager will only pay the entry fee of a competitor. A 50% discount will be offered on the second entry fee when a competitor is flying in more than one class

• TERMS OF PAYMENT

All fees must be received by the organizers at 15/06/ 2024. This also includes payment for banquet etc. (acc. to Final Entry Form). For entry fees received later than 15/06/2024, participants must pay an additional fee of 15%. The entry fee paid at the contest site will be increased by 20% and must be paid in cash at the contest office.

• BOARD AND LODGING

In Ploiesti there are many 3*** and 4**** hotels as well as motels and guesthouses where you can book accommodation. (around €50/night/pers)

The Organizer can provide help with board and lodging in Ploiesti, with double room, single room, bath room, Tv, wi-fi, including breakfast and dinner in restaurants hotel and hot lunch, water on contest site. The traditional Romanian food is prepared only from natural products. The organizers will help you find the best solution.

- **INSURANCE**

The organizer will provide a limited third-party liability insurance covering all competitors for model accidents involving injury to others and damage to property. It is recommended that individual health and travel insurance is purchased before travelling. For EU citizens, health care is covered under Social Health Care on presentation of an EU 11 form available in the country of residence. Citizens from outside of EU should provide their own health insurance to cover illness and travel insurance.

The Organizers are not responsible for any kind of PERSONAL injury, loss, theft or damage to people or property OUTSIDE OF THE COMPETITION. The Organizers will cover third party damage during the contest.

- **FREQUENCIES**

Only 2.4 GHz spread spectrum radio control systems are allowed (output power up to 100 mW according to EN 300 328 Standard).

- **VISA REQUIREMENTS**

For those countries where the Romanian Entry Visa is asked for, it can be obtained from The Romanian Embassies/Consulates. For more information, please consult the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. (www.mae.ro/en/node/2040) Citizens belonging to the countries members of EU do not need an Entry Visa.

• **PRACTICE FLIGHTS / TRAINING SCHEDULE**

Practice Flying will take place from Thursday, Aug. 8 until Saturday, Aug. 10 based on a line up system controlled by the flightline directors. Practice flying takes place at the very same place as the contest flights. No practice flights will be allowed for the duration of the contest after the first round of flying has commenced.

- **MODEL AIRCRAFT SPECIFICATION CERTIFICATES AND CONTESTANT DECLARATION FORM**

The fully completed, signed and stamped by the applicable NAC, Model Aircraft Specification Certificates and Contestant Declaration Forms for each team member must be handed in during the initial registration (3 copies).

Documents to be presented at registration:

- entry form signed and stamped by the National Aero Club / National Federation
- Valid FAI Licences of competitors, Team-Manager, Team-Mangers Assistant
- The holder of a FAI Sporting Licence may be required to produce an official document bearing his photograph and signature as proof of identity.
- The proof of payment of entry fee and fuel - Model certificates to be presented only during model processing
- 2 national flags, approx. 1 x 1.5 m
- National anthem on USB-Stick At the registration the team manager will receive the ID cards, Information and program folder, souvenirs and the banquet voucher (if ordered). The national flags and the anthem will be returned to the Team Manager after the Closing Ceremony.

- **AIRFIELD ACCESS AND OPENING HOURS**

The Hangars will be closed and locked from 20:00 to 07:00

INTERNET ACCESS

There will be wireless internet at the airfield

ELECTRICITY

50Hz/230Volt power will be provided on site and in the model storage area. Each team may bring their own power converters and plug adapters to the Romanian standard outlet (find it at your local DIY-Store).

- **NATIONAL CURRENCY** 1 LEU=100 BANI

There are banknotes of 1 LEU, 5 LEI, 10 LEI, 50 LEI, 100 LEI, 200 LEI and 500 LEI.
